

SOIL WETTER PRO

FOR SOIL WETTING AND WATER RETENTION

SOIL WETTER Pro is a very effective agent that enables water to penetrate into soil, reducing run-off and holding it in the root zone where plants can access it the most. A fast acting, long-lasting and biodegradable product that reduces water loss and evaporation.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SOIL WETTER Pro is best applied in cool conditions preferably before rain or irrigation. Avoid direct contact with sensitive vegetation as burning may occur. **SOIL WETTER Pro** should be used at a dilution rate of 500mL per 100L of water. Do not exceed 1L/100L of water. When using **SOIL WETTER Pro** in a new situation or on sensitive crops, test crop sensitivity by application to a small area prior to wide scale use.

SITUATION	APPLICATION RATE*	CRITICAL COMMENTS
Broadacre	2 – 5L/ha	Use for strip spraying directly over seeding lines
Horticulture, Vines and Orchards	Spray applications 2 – 10L/ha	For spray applications, use at least 100L of water for each 1L of SOIL WETTER Pro . Use the higher rate in severe conditions or for very water repellent soils
	Irrigation systems 2 – 5L/ha	For direct addition to irrigation systems, Pre-dilute SOIL WETTER Pro in water (no more than 1Lt /100L water). Apply to irrigation feed line at start of irrigation period.
Turf	2 – 10L/ha	Apply in a minimum of 2000L/ha. Watering shortly after application is recommended.
Home Garden	2 – 10mL/m ²	Dilute 30mL in 9L of water. Apply over 3 – 4m ²

SOIL WETTER Pro will remain active in the soil for up to 12 weeks after application.

*Application Rate should be calculated as amount of product on treated area. When applying to strips, rows or individual plants, only the treated area should be considered.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

MIXING

1. Half fill tank with water
2. Add **SOIL WETTER Pro** and mix thoroughly.
3. Add remaining water

CAUTION: Foaming may occur. Avoid excessive aeration of spray tank.

COMPATIBILITY

SOIL WETTER Pro is preferably applied alone. If mixing with other products a jar test is recommended or consult your reseller or RONIC International for specific instructions.

SPILLAGE

In the event of spillage absorb onto sand or chemical absorbent. Remove residue with detergent and hot water. Dispose of by normal waste disposal methods conforming to local authority codes. DO NOT contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with the chemical or used containers.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Store in the closed, original container, in a well-ventilated area, out of direct sunlight. Avoid storage below 0°C as this product may become cloudy and thicken. Above 0°C, it returns to its normal clear fluid state. Triple, or preferably pressure rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsing to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If no landfill is available, bury the containers below 500mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots. Do not burn empty containers or product.
